Tanzania To Reopen

The official words from the Tanzania government are the schools will reopen the 29th day of June; and the airlines have resumed international flights as of the 28th of May. President Magufuli announced that arriving passengers into Tanzania would not be required to enter mandatory quarantine but would only have their temperature checked. As most of you know a large part of

the country's revenue comes from tourism. The recent health threat has all but brought that industry to a halt and threatens to greatly harm Tanzania's already-fragile economy. After learning that the cases of the virus have gone down, the president's response was, "If they have no signs of corona, let them go see the animals."

Although the president has received quite a bit of criticism from neighboring countries for his decisions, at least for now there is the possibility of going back to Tanzania in the near future. Whether we or anyone else decides to do so will be up to the individual.

Originally Mary and I had planned to accompany Nathan and Kristi for a trip this summer during what normally is a very busy time of year at Chimala. Normally there are groups of medical students who spend several weeks working with the hospital. There are also the preachers', women's, and youth's seminars as well as the Gospel Chariot campaigns. But because we were not sure how the summer months would turn out, we all postponed updating our visas, etc. At this point, even if we wanted to plan a late summer trip, we would have to apply and wait for our visas. Furthermore, since Nathan and Kristi are required to have a resident/ work permit as they plan to move to Tanzania in January, they would really be better off beginning the permit process now. And according to Tanzania's immigration law, you cannot enter Tanzania while your permit is



being processed. And there is one more very important factor—at least for me to consider: visiting supporting churches. Because travel has been restrictive and churches have been closed, I have only been able to visit a handful of churches this year. I have a lot of scheduling and catching-up to do with only a little over half a year left! I will do my best to contact and visit as many churches as possible. So open or not open, there are a lot of other factors to consider before we make a final decision. Howell

Howell Ferguson Conversions Amidst Challenges

Our continued hope and prayer is that all the Chimala Mission schools can return

to a measure of normalcy soon. As you might imagine, there have been a number of challenges not only in the work that needs done but also in the financial aspects of the mission, particularly the primary and secondary schools.

Unlike the Chimala School of Preaching, CMPS and HCSS are funded through student tuition fees. When the

Tanzania president ordered all schools closed all the boarding students returned home and the local day students remained at home. As you can imagine, the financial fallout was there were very few school fees collected. Teachers and staff still

need to eat and feed their families, hence the With challenge. the reopening of the schools, we pray that problem will basically take of care itself hopefully with minimal outside help.

The CSOP staff met to discuss June's plans and decided not to conduct the summer seminars or the Gospel Chariot campaigns. Despite these temporary

setbacks, CSOP continues to teach and evangelize with its current staff. Seven baptisms were reported recently in late May one of which can be seen in this photo.

An Idea To Consider

Probably most of you reading this newsletter received your "stimulus" check as we did. I do not remember in my lifetime the US government doing such a thing. The theory is that the money the US government sent you will help restore our lagging economy when you put it back into the economy by spending it on something.

While we don't know the complete financial fall-out of the situation our country is in, I would like you to stop for a moment and consider there are countries that have undergone similar plunges in their economies but with no stimulus checks on the horizon. For example, since the Tanzania government closed all schools, the Chimala Mission Primary School and Herring Christian Secondary School have also had to close. As a general rule, these schools receive very little US support. They were set-up to be self-supported schools funded by student tuition fees. Consequently the salaries of their teachers, administrators and staff have been greatly reduced or ended since there are no students nor tuition fees. Most of them have not been paid for 2 months. These schools do not accumulate funds but operate on a month-to-month basis on very tight budgets.

Here's my point and my plea. If you as a Christian brother or sister are fortunate enough to still have employment and have received a stimulus check from the government; rather than spending it on something for yourself, how about considering helping Christian teachers teaching children from a Christian world-view at the Chimala Mission? Please just give it some thought. Howell

A few days ago Frank Mwashikumbulu met a little boy while out evangelizing. While his English is a little bit challenging, you can easily understand what Frank has to say about this child's illness.

I met a child who is 6 years old and was crying so much as the child was very swelling in the stomach. I taken the child to his house where I met with his mother. I asked about the problem of the child, then his mother started _____

to tell me history of the disease of the child. She got pregnancy when she was fifteen years old. After that she got a baby who has a problem of defect system. She taken her child to the hospital for his problem. The doctors gave a baby sugary and put pipe through the stomach in order to help the baby to defect and they told her mother to be back at hospital after two month, but his mother didn't go back at hospital until today because of the money. So by now the child is in real painful and swelling the stomach. After seeing a child I stated crying myself because I'm a parent as you are. So my request to you brethren is to save the life of the child by helping some money which will help the



child to go to the big hospital for his problem. Please brethren I know every one has a problem, but for this child is too much. Maybe even you if you can saw a child you will start crying like me. I wrote this because I believe you can do something for the child. My God be with you and to those who will share with you by saving the life of the child.

We did not wait but have already sent 1 million Tsh (about \$435) for this little boy's treatment. He has a serious problem with his digestive system. He will be taken to a hospital in Mbeya that has the means to treat this type of illness. Howell
