# Howell Ferguson **Back for a Short Visit**

Three weeks is the shortest time we've spent at Chimala in probably over five years; but this was on purpose. Not only do we normally plan a summer trip, but we also wanted to coordinate our return trip with Nathan, Kristi, Eden, Emmy and Rowan for their furlough. I also needed to get back to the States in time for the Polishing the Pulpit event in Sevierville, TN as I'm scheduled to speak.

Originally I had hoped the timing of our shipping container would have coincided with this trip. But it is actually very uncommon for anything involving the TZ government to match our schedules. But I am confident discussing this with our administrator, Menard Swila that everything will be handled properly once the container finally arrives at Chimala. As of this writing, the container is scheduled to arrive in Dar mid-August, over two weeks later than we were originally told. So the "hakuna matata" factor has risen it's head again and must be allowed to run its course. To fight against it has been, in my experience, an exercise in vanity and frustration.

But one of the bright spots of returning to Chimala was to see the hospital's X-ray machine operational again. Remember that it was over a year ago when a bad lightning strike shut down our ability to perform X-rays. This was so detrimental to the hospital,

and there was no quick remedy in sight. But it is now being used and is resulting in returning patients as well as confidence in our hospital. Also good news, the fabrication of large replacement part for our hydraulic ram (hydram) has been completed and expected to be shipped from Great Britain very soon.

## My Favoriate Co-Worker

Having someone stick by you through thick-or-thin is a blessing without equal. Mary has been working on getting the two storage rooms ready for receiving the contents of the shipping container. The storage rooms are actually one building that has two sections with the general storage room nearly double the size of the missionary storage side. It's located inside what is called the "shop"—a walled area on the mission around two acres in size. Among the works that are done there include carpentry, automotive, welding and metal fabrication, electrical and plumbing. There is also extensive space for storage of tools, equipment and supplies.

At the arrival of the container, the larger items such as the X-ray machine, refrigerated mortuary and examination table will be off-loaded and taken directly to the hospital. General and personal missionary supplies will go into the mission side storage; while general mission supplies will go on the other side. Of course, a large portion of the supplies are for the hospital and schools. So as many of those supplies will go directly to those departments as they have space. Also, we try to "rotate" any existing items so that the existing supplies are



used before opening supplies recently received.

Obviously, you can imagine the amount of work that goes into keeping up with such inventory and knowing the best way in distributing supplies. I normally have so many other matters to attend to that I'm not always aware of such things. But having Mary work with me with the Chimala Mission has been such a great blessing not only in these matters, but for everything in my life. She is an experienced and creative teacher of children (also in Swahili); and she is never more happy than to be at a "bush" village teaching highly-energetic children about God's love through Jesus Christ.
