# **Planting Seed at Ailsa**

The year 2024 represents the beginning of the fifth season of the Chimala Mission Farm Program. In a perfect world, the mission would have perfectly flat land with all the advantages of modern American farming. But the Ailsa farm is a rough and unforgiving piece of property surrounded by mountains, deep canyons, seasonal fire hazards, and sometimes unfriendly neighbors. It creates a deep respect within me when I reflect upon the struggles of the early German families that once labored to make a living from this land. In many ways, we are discovering the same lessons these earlier inhabitants learned. The sweat of their brow was to provide for their family needs; the sweat of our brow is to create a self-sustaining mission ultimately to be led by the local Tanzanian brethren.
