"For Jonathan's sake"

Years had passed following the tragic death of King Saul and his son, Jonathan on the slopes of Mount Gilboa at the hands of the Philistines.

Unknown to David, when the news arrived that Israel's King and Crown Prince were dead, those in the palace were seized with fear and fled for their lives. In the panic of terror, a nurse dropped a little 5-year-old boy, crippling him to never walk again. This little boy's name was Mephibosheth, the son of Jonathan. The battle ended the rule of Saul and nearly wiped out his family. Mephibosheth grew to manhood in obscurity.

Now in quiet deliberation, King David wished to do something good in memory of his friendship with Jonathan. "Is there not still someone of the house of Saul, to whom I may show the kindness of God? And Ziba said to the king, There is still a son of Jonathan who is lame in his feet" (2 Samuel 9:3).

Power Outage Solution

"Hello, Firstly let me begin by expressing my gratitude for the money that was sent to the hospital to help out with salaries. As I reported to you earlier, we have 21 people leaving at the end of this month, and we will keep dropping some more with expiry of contracts. Our expectation is that the December salaries will be way down.

Apart from that we are facing a serious power outage which forces us to use the hospital generator, that as you know produces unclean power which endangers the equipment. While we can't stay without power due to many patients using oxygen machines, babies on warmers, using generators is very expensive. Burton suggested that we add new 7 batteries to our solar power system, as that can help us use less money.

So my request here is that if there is any donor willing to donate money for seven batteries, I was told that each battery is 700,000 tshs, they will be saving a lot of lives.

On the neonatal unit we have constructed a little room inside the OB ward, enough for 4 beds as photos attached here under will show.

Tomorrow I am meeting an auditor, I plan to discuss with him on doing an audit at the hospital to prevent or reduce the risk of being penalized again, we will come up with ways to better manage our affairs as they relate to Revenue authorities.
